**SECTION 1 - TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS**

**Access Line** - An arrangement which connects the Customer's telephone to a IdealDial designated switching center or point of presence.

**Authorization Code** - A pre-defined series of numbers to be dialed by the Customer or Authorized User upon access to the Carrier's Travel Service network to identify the caller and validate the caller's authorization to use the services provided.

**Authorized User** - A person, firm, corporation, or any other entity authorized by the Customer to utilize the Carrier's service.

**Commission** - The Idaho Public Utilities Commission unless otherwise clearly indicated by the context.

**Company or Carrier** - IdealDial Corporation unless otherwise clearly indicated by the context.

**Customer** - The person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders, cancels, amends or uses service and is responsible for payment of charges and compliance with the Company's price list.

**Equal Access** - Where the local exchange company central office provides interconnection to interexchange carriers with Feature Group D circuits. In such end offices, customers presubscribe their telephone line(s) to their preferred interLATA carrier.

**IdealDial** - Used throughout this price list to refer to IdealDial Corporation

**LEC** - Local Exchange Company.

**SECTION 1 - TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS, (CONT'D.)**

**Personal Identification Number (PIN)** - See Authorization Code. PINs may also be used in conjunction with shared 800 service to uniquely identify the terminating location for an incoming call. Upon dialing a shared 800 number, the caller enters the PIN number associated with the party they are trying to reach.

**Serving Wire Center** - A specified geographic point from which the vertical and horizontal coordinate is used in calculation of airline mileage.

**Switched Access Origination/Termination** - Where access between the customer and the interexchange carrier is provided on local exchange company Feature Group circuits and the connection to the customer is a LEC-provided business or residential access line. The cost of switched Feature Group access is billed to the interexchange carrier.

**Travel Card Call** - A service whereby the Customer or Authorized User dials all of the digits necessary to route and bill a call placed from a location other than his/her residence or normal place of business. Service is accessed via a "1-800" or other access code dialing sequence.

**V & H Coordinates** - Geographic points which define the originating and terminating points of a call in mathematical terms so that the airline mileage of the call may be determined. Call mileage may be used for the purposed of rating calls.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS****2.1 Undertaking of IdealDial**

IdealDial's services and resold facilities are furnished for intraLATA and interLATA communications originating at specified points within the state of Idaho under terms of this price list.

IdealDial installs, operates, and maintains the communications services provided hereinunder in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this price list. IdealDial may act as the Customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities, when authorized by the Customer, to allow connection of a Customer's location to the IdealDial network. The Customer shall be responsible for all charges due for such service arrangement.

The Company's services and resold facilities are provided on a monthly basis unless otherwise provided, and are available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week.

**2.2 Limitations**

- 2.2.1** Service is offered subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and equipment and subject to the provisions of this price list.
- 2.2.2** IdealDial reserves the right to discontinue or limit service when necessitated by conditions beyond its control, or when the Customer is using service in violation of provisions of this price list, or in violation of the law.
- 2.2.3** The Company does not undertake to transmit messages, but offers the use of its facilities when available, and will not be liable for errors in transmission or for failure to establish connections.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)****2.2 Limitations, (Cont'd.)**

2.2.4 All services and resold facilities provided under this price list are directly or indirectly controlled by IdealDial and the Customer may not transfer or assign the use of service or facilities without the express written consent of the Company. Such transfer or assignment shall only apply where there is no interruption of the use or location of the service or facilities.

2.2.5 Prior written permission from the Company is required before any assignment or transfer. All regulations and conditions contained in this price list shall apply to all such permitted assignees or transferees, as well as all conditions of service.

2.2.6 Presubscribed service is available from equal access locations only. Travel service is available from any originating location in the state.

**2.4 Payment for Service**

All charges due by the Customer are payable to IdealDial or any agency duly authorized to receive such payments. Any objections to billed charges must be reported to the Company within thirty (30) days of the invoice date. Adjustments to Customer's bills shall be made to the extent that circumstances exist which reasonably indicate that such changes are appropriate.

**2.4.1 Late Payment Fees**

A late payment fee of 1.5% per month will be charged on any past due balance. Any applicable late payment fees will be assessed according to the terms and conditions of the Company or its billing agent and pursuant to Pennsylvania law.

**2.4.2 Return Check Charge**

A return check charge of \$20.00 will be assessed for checks returned for insufficient funds. Any applicable return check charges will be assessed according to the terms and conditions of the Company or its billing agent and pursuant to Pennsylvania law.

**2.5 Taxes**

Unless otherwise specified in this price list, all state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the quoted rates.

**2.6 Cancellation**

Customers must provide thirty days written notification to IdealDial prior to cancellation. Customers are responsible for all charges, including fixed fees, which accrue up to the cancellation date.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)****2.7 Refunds or Credits for Service Outages or Deficiencies**

Credit allowances for interruptions of service which are not due to the Company's testing or adjusting, to the negligence of the Customer or Subscriber, or to the failure of channels, equipment and/or communications systems provided by the Customer or Subscriber, are subject to the general liability provisions set forth in this price list. It shall be the obligation of the Customer to notify Company immediately of any interruption in service for which a credit allowance is desired by Customer. Before giving such notice, the Customer shall ascertain that the trouble is not within his or her control, or is not in wiring or equipment, if any, furnished by Customer. Interruptions caused by Customer-provided, Subscriber-provided or Company-provided automatic dialing equipment are not deemed an interruption of service as defined herein since the Customer has the option of using the long distance network via LEC access. For purposes of credit computation every month shall be considered to have 30 days. For services with a monthly recurring charge, no credit shall be allowed for an interruption of continuous duration of less than twenty-four hours. For message rated toll services, credits will be limited to, at maximum, the price of the initial period of individual call that was interrupted.

The Customer shall be credited for an interruption of one day (24 hours) or more at the rate of 1/30th of the monthly charge for the services affected for each day that the interruption continues.

Credit Formula:

$$\text{Credit} = A/30 \times B$$

A = outage time in days

B = total monthly charge for affected service.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)****2.8 800 Numbers**

- 2.8.1 The Company will make every effort to reserve "800" vanity numbers on behalf of customers, but makes no guarantee or warrantee that the requested "800" number(s) will be available or assigned to the customer requesting the number.
- 2.8.2 If a Customer accumulates undisputed past-due charges, the Company reserves the right not to honor the Customer's request for a change in 800 service to another carrier (e.g., "porting" of the 800 number), including a request for a Responsible Organization (Resp Org) change, until such time as all charges are paid in full.
- 2.8.3 800 numbers shared by more than one Customer, whereby individual customers are identified by a unique Personal Identification Number, may not be assigned or transferred for use with service provided by another carrier. Subject to the limitations provided in Section 2.8.2, the company will only honor Customer requests for change in Resp Org or 800 service provider for 800 numbers dedicated to the sole use of that single Customer.

**2.9 Other Rules**

The Company reserves the right to discontinue service, limit service, or to impose requirements on Customers as required to meet changing regulatory rules and standards of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission.

**SECTION 3 - SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS AND RATES****3.1 General**

IdealDial provides direct dialed (1+) service, inbound 800 number service, travel card service and prepaid card services for communications originating and terminating within the state of Idaho under terms of this price list. Operator services and directory assistance are not furnished by IdealDial. Operator services and directory assistance service will be provided and billed by the Company's underlying carrier.

Customers are billed based on their use of IdealDial Corporation's network and services. Charges may vary by service offering, mileage band, class of call, time of day, day of week, and/or call duration.

**3.2 Timing of Calls**

Billing for calls placed over the IdealDial network is based in part on the duration of the call as follows, unless otherwise specified in this price list:

- 3.2.1 Call timing begins when the called party answers the call (i.e. when two way communications are established.) Answer detection is based on standard industry answer detection methods, including hardware and software answer detection.
- 3.2.2 Chargeable time for calls ends when one of the parties disconnects from the call.
- 3.2.3 Minimum call duration periods for billing purposes vary by service option and are specified on a per plan basis.
- 3.2.4 For billing purposes, usage after the initial period varies by service and is specified on a per plan basis.
- 3.2.5 The Company will not bill for unanswered calls. When a Customer indicates that he/she was billed for an incomplete call, IdealDial will reasonably issue credit for the call.

**3.3.3 Holiday Rates**

For services subject to holiday discounts, the following are Company recognized national holidays, determined at the location of the calling station. The evening rate is used on national holidays, unless a lower rate normally would apply.

**SECTION 3 - SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS AND RATES, (CONT'D.)****3.4 Calculation of Distance**

Usage charges for all mileage sensitive products are based on the airline distance between serving wire centers associated with the originating and terminating points of the call.

The serving wire centers of a call are determined by the area codes and exchanges of the origination and destination points.

The distance between the Wire Center of the Customer's equipment and that of the destination point is calculated by using the "V" and "H" coordinates found in BellCore's V&H Tape and NECA FCC Tariff No. 4.

- Step 1 - Obtain the "V" and "H" coordinates for the Wire Centers serving the Customer and the destination point.
- Step 2 - Obtain the difference between the "V" coordinates of each of the Wire Centers. Obtain the Difference between the "H" coordinates.
- Step 3 - Square the differences obtained in Step 2.
- Step 4 - Add the squares of the "V" difference and "H" difference obtained in Step 3.
- Step 5 - Divide the sum of the square obtained in Step 4 by ten (10). Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction results from the division.
- Step 6 - Obtain the square root of the whole number obtained in Step 5. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained. This is the distance between the Wire Centers.

**3.7.2 Travel Service - Option 2 (Debit Card)**

Travel Service - Option 2 is offered as a flat-rated travel card account service. Establishment of an account balance entitles the consumer to access the Carrier's network for a preset amount of usage. Option 2 usage will be debited from the available account balance in full-minute increments on a real-time basis. Customers will be interrupted with an announcement when the account balance is about to be exhausted.

Debit cards containing account numbers and dialing instructions are available in various denominations. The debit card is non-refundable and will expire on the date specified on the card or package in which the card is enclosed. Any unused balances may be applied toward any replenishment amount. Unlike a deposit or advance payment, the debit card account balance is not held against future payment as all service is available for immediate consumption.

For billing purposes, Option 2 usage is rounded up to the next full minute increment after a minimum initial period of one (1) minute.
