**Carrier or Company** - Whenever used in this tariff, "Carrier" or "Company" refers to TTI Telecommunications, Inc. unless otherwise specified or clearly indicated by the context.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**2.1 Undertaking of TTI**

TTI's services and resold facilities are furnished for intraLATA and interLATA communications originating at specified points within the state of Idaho under terms of this tariff.

TTI installs, operates, and maintains the communications services provided hereinunder in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this tariff. TTI may act as the Customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities, when authorized by the Customer, to allow connection of a Customer's location to the TTI network. The Customer shall be responsible for all charges due for such service arrangement.

The Company's services and resold facilities are provided on a monthly basis unless otherwise provided, and are available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week.

**2.2 Limitations**

- 2.2.1 Service is offered subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and equipment and subject to the provisions of this tariff.
- 2.2.2 TTI reserves the right to discontinue or limit service when necessitated by conditions beyond its control, or when the Customer is using service in violation of provisions of this tariff, or in violation of the law.
- 2.2.3 The Company does not undertake to transmit messages, but offers the use of its facilities when available, and will not be liable for errors in transmission or for failure to establish connections.

**2.2 Limitations, con't.**

2.2.4 All services and resold facilities provided under this tariff are directly or indirectly controlled by TTI and the Customer may not transfer or assign the use of service or facilities without the express written consent of the Company. Such transfer or assignment shall only apply where there is no interruption of the use or location of the service or facilities.

2.2.5 Prior written permission from the Company is required before any assignment or transfer. All regulations and conditions contained in this tariff shall apply to all such permitted assignees or transferees, as well as all conditions of service.

**2.3 Use**

Services provided under this tariff may be used for any lawful purpose for which the service is technically suited.

**2.4 Payment for Service**

All charges due by the Customer are payable to TTI or any agency duly authorized to receive such payments. Any objections to billed charges must be reported to the Company within thirty (30) days of the invoice date. Adjustments to Customer's bills shall be made to the extent that circumstances exist which reasonably indicate that such changes are appropriate.

Customers are responsible for all charges associated with their account, including all charges placed against Travel Card numbers. Customers claiming not to be responsible for more than five calls on any one statement may be required to accept a Travel Card number change issued by TTI.

**SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, con't.****2.9 Payment for Service, continued**

The Customer is responsible for all charges associated with the Customer's account, including calls made using TTI's service from the Customer's local telephone service numbers, and the use of Travel Card account or authorization codes. The Company is not liable for any damages, including toll usage charges, the Customer may incur as a result of unauthorized use of its telecommunications facilities. This unauthorized use of telecommunications facilities includes, but is not limited to, the placement of calls from the Customer's premises, the placement of calls through Customer-provided equipment which are transmitted or carried on TTI's network and the placement of calls via access numbers and authorization codes. TTI will work with Customers to recommend possible solutions to reduce unauthorized use of their facilities. However, TTI does not warrant or guarantee that its recommendations will prevent all unauthorized use, and the Customer is responsible for controlling access to, and the use of, its own telephone facilities and access codes.

Customer responsibility for payment includes payment for long distance message telephone service calls or services originated at the Customer's numbers, placed from another location through the use of a travel card or debit card authorization number, or the use of a company assigned special billing number.

This responsibility is not changed by virtue of any use, misuse, or abuse of the Customer's service or Customer-provided systems, equipment, facilities or services interconnected to the Customer's local telephone service, dedicated lines or 800 service which may be caused by third parties, including but not limited to, the Customer's employees and unauthorized members of the public.

**2.5 Taxes**

All state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the quoted rates.

**2.6 Reconnection**

For customers disconnected for reasons of non-payment, a \$25.00 reconnection charge applies.

**2.7 Return Check Charge**

A return check charge of \$15.00 is applied to a Customer's account each time a check is returned to TTI by a bank for insufficient funds.

**2.8 Cancellation**

Customers must provide thirty days written notification to TTI prior to cancellation. Customers are responsible for all charges, including fixed fees, which accrue up to the cancellation date.

**2.9 Other Rules**

- 2.9.1 The Company reserves the right to discontinue service, limit service, or to impose requirements on Customers as required to meet changing regulatory rules and standards of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission.

**SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE, con't.****3.3 Determination of Mileage**

(A) Calls are measured and rounded to the higher full minute from the Serving Wire Center of the originating Customer's terminal or switch location to the Serving Wire Center of the destination of the call.

(B) The distance between the Serving Wire Center of the Customer's switch and that of the destination point is calculated by using the vertical ("V") and horizontal ("H") coordinates as defined in the BellCore V&H Coordinates Tape and NECA Tariff FCC No. 4 in the following manner:

Step 1 - Obtain the "V" and "H" coordinates for the originating and destination points.

Step 2 - Obtain the difference between the "V" coordinates of each of the Serving Wire Centers. Obtain the difference between the "H" coordinates.

Step 3 - Square the differences obtained in Step 2.

Step 4 - Add the squares of the "V" difference and "H" difference obtained in Step 3.

Step 5 - Divide the sum of the squares obtained in Step 4 by ten (10). Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction results from the division.

Step 6 - Obtain the square root of the whole number obtained in Step 5. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained. This is the distance between the Serving Wire Centers.
