- 2.1 Check Sheets. When a tariff (price sheet) filing is made with the Commission, an updated Check Sheet accompanies the filing. The Check Sheet lists the sheets contained in the filing with a cross reference to the current revision number. When new pages are added, the check sheet is changed to reflect the revision.
- 2.2 Numbering (An example). Sheet numbers appear in the upper left corner of each page. Sheets are numbered sequentially. When a new sheet is added between sheets already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new sheet added between sheets 6 and 7 would be 6.1.
 - 2.2.1 Sheet revision numbers also appear in the upper left corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current sheet version on file with the the Commission. - d. The Company has tried diligently to meet the notice requirements of the Commission's Rule 304, but has been unsuccessful in its attempt to contact the Customer affected.
- e. The Customer has misrepresented the Customer's identity for purposes of obtaining telephone service and has an outstanding bill exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars.

6. **Service Offering**

6.1 The Company's services are offered to subscribers on a monthly basis.

6.1.1 The Company's services are offered twenty-four hours a day.

6.1.2 The Company's service agreement is in effect for a minimum of thirty days.

6.2 Liability.

The included tariff language does not constitute a determination by the Commission that a limitation of liability imposed by the Company should be upheld in a court of law. Acceptance for filing by the Commission recognizes that it is a court's responsibility to adjudicate negligence and consequential damage claims. It is also the court's responsibility to determine the validity of the exculpatory clause.

The Customer will be liable for damages to the facilities of the Company caused by negligence or willful acts of its officers, employees, agents or contractors of the Customer.

6.3 The Company will give at least ten (10) days notice to Customers and the Commission before increasing rates or other changes. The notice to Customers will be either individual notice or a public notice in the newspapers in the Company's Idaho service areas.
